The Bureau of Justice Assistance National Training and Technical Assistance Center (BJA NTTAC) facilitates the delivery of training and technical assistance (TTA) to the criminal justice community. By providing rapid, expert, coordinated, and data driven TTA, the BJA NTTAC team supports practitioners in their efforts to reduce crime, recidivism, and unnecessary confinement, making communities safer. Utilizing a vast provider network, the BJA NTTAC team connects state, local, and tribal justice agencies with subject matter experts to address their communities' specific public safety needs.

#### What We Do

The BJA NTTAC team provides no-cost TTA, both in-person and virtually, on a variety of criminal justice topics, including adjudication, corrections, crime prevention, justice information-sharing, mental health, substance abuse, tribal justice, and capacity-building. Services range from short-term to more comprehensive, longer-term engagements and may include assistance implementing evidence-based programs and strategies, curriculum development, data analysis, classroom or virtual training, and strategic planning.

#### **Additional Services We Offer**

In addition to our specialized TTA services, BJA NTTAC offers resources and tools that have been developed to address emerging issues and key trends in the criminal justice arena. These free resources include:

- On-Demand TTA Programs BJA NTTAC has developed teams of consultants who can quickly respond to TTA requests by identifying gaps and needs and providing recommendations in specific topical areas, including:
  - Crime Analysis on Demand Enhances an agency's ability to analyze and use data to make informed decisions, respond effectively, and prevent crime



- Prosecution Assessments Assesses the capacity of prosecutors' offices to prosecute violent crime and identifies the strengths, gaps, and adjustments needed to enhance results
- Technology Assessments Assesses an agency's technical resources and abilities, and provides actionable recommendations to enhance their technology-driven initiatives and train personnel
- TTA Catalog This online resource is available to TTA providers to promote upcoming webinars, training opportunities, and technical assistance to the justice community. Criminal justice agencies can search the TTA Catalog to find events based on their need and location. In addition to events, the TTA Catalog allows users to browse or search through the list of BJA TTA provider organizations.
