

Liz Ryan was sworn in as Administrator of the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) on May 16, 2022, following appointment by President Biden.

OJJDP envisions a nation where all children are free from crime and violence. Youth contact with the justice system should be **rare**, **fair**, and **beneficial**.





#### **Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP)**

#### **OJJDP Priorities:**

- Treat children as children.
- Serve children at home, with their families, in their communities.
- Open up opportunities for system-involved youth.

#### **OJJDP's Overarching Principles:**

- Centering the voices of system-involved youth and families.
- Ending racial inequity within the juvenile justice system.


